Administrative/Biographical History:

Frank Polk was born in San Angelo, Texas in 1942. Polk received his B.A. from the University of Texas at Austin in 1963, his M. D. from Baylor College of Medicine in 1967; and his M. Sc. from Harvard University School of Public Health in 1976. Polk was a resident at St. Luke's Hospital in New York and at Peter Bent Brigham Hospital in Boston. During the 1970s, he was an Assistant Professor of Medicine at Harvard Medical School and a physician at several hospitals in the Northeast including Boston City Hospital, Beth Israel Hospital, Boston Hospital for Women, New England Deaconess Hospital, and Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston. During this time he taught courses on Infectious Disease and served on Infection Control Committees.

Polk held appointments at Johns Hopkins University from 1982 until his death in 1988. From 1982 until 1985 he was an Associate Professor of Epidemiology in the Department of Epidemiology within the School of Hygiene and Public Health. He held a joint appointment in the School of Medicine, as Associate Professor of Medicine in the Department of Medicine and in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology. From 1985 until 1988 Polk was a Professor in each of the three Departments and the Director of the Infectious Disease Epidemiology Program in the Department of Epidemiology at the School of Hygiene and Public Health. He taught courses on Epidemiology, Reproductive and Perinatal Disorders, and AIDS.

Polk conducted research on reproductive disorders, hypertension, cancer and nutrition, and AIDS. While at Harvard he cared for one of Boston's first AIDS patients. Polk was a key figure in the early efforts at Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions to address AIDS as a public health threat and to provide treatment for AIDS patients. Early on he recognized and warned of the possibility of an epidemic. In 1983 he designed a study to follow the natural history

of the disease among gay and bisexual men. The National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases, within NIH, selected Polk's project, which became known as "the Study to Help the AIDS Research Effort (SHARE)," to be the Baltimore site of the longitudinal Multicenter AIDS Cohort Study (MACS). In forming SHARE's advisory board, Polk approached members of the gay community of Baltimore in order to obtain advice about recruitment, publicity, interviewing, confidentiality and other matters about which sensitivity regarding gay lifestyle was important, but which researchers may not have understood. MACS is still ongoing; in addition to Baltimore, it includes sites in Chicago, Pittsburgh and Los Angeles.

Polk was an Advisory Board Member of the First AIDS Service at Johns Hopkins University, the clinical care component of the Johns Hopkins Hospital for serving AIDS patients. In 1984 he established the Outpatient Clinic for patients with HIV infection. Located at the Moore Clinic, it was the first AIDS Clinic in Maryland. Polk served as the director and provided evaluation, treatment, and counsel. In 1986 Polk helped initiate the Hospital's AIDS Inpatient Unit, the 3rd in the country at the time. Polk conducted studies on AIDS transmission and treatment including the risk of HIV infection for recipients of blood transfusions, prison inmates, intravenous drug users, and transmission from mothers to their unborn child. He conducted early studies of experimental drug treatments. Polk was concerned with both immunological and social issues. He was an advocate of AIDS education. He conducted seminars for Baltimore city school principals and collaborated with Maryland Public Television in developing an AIDS video. During the early years of the disease's discovery he encouraged public officials to keep schools open to AIDS patients. He was an early advocate of clean needle exchange programs for IV drug users. Polk served on scientific task forces for the state of Maryland as well as numerous committees and advisory councils pertaining to Obstetrics and Gynecology and AIDS. He co-authored more than 100 scientific articles. He died of a brain tumor in 1988 at the age of 46. In 1989 the AIDS inpatient unit at Johns Hopkins Hospital was named after Polk.

Scope and Content:

The B. Frank Polk Collection consists of Polk's teaching and course files, correspondence, committee files, research materials, and publications relating to his work as a faculty member at The Johns Hopkins University School of Public Health in the Department of Epidemiology and at the School of Medicine in the Departments of Medicine and Gynecology and Obstetrics. The papers document the leadership role Polk played as part of the effort at the Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions to prioritize, understand, and treat patients with AIDS in the years following the appearance of the disease. Polk was active in the creation of an AIDS Treatment Unit at the Johns Hopkins Hospital. The collection includes Polk's research files in Obstetrics and Gynecology and his research on AIDS transmission and treatment. It includes records pertaining to a longitudinal AIDS Study, MACS, the Multicenter AIDS Cohort Study. Polk was the principle investigator for SHARE (Study to Help the AIDS Research Effort), the Baltimore arm of the MACS study. The collection contains an extensive set of reprints of articles co-authored by Polk.

Scope and Content:

The Johns Hopkins Institutional Records comprise Polk's teaching and administrative files for the School of Hygiene and Public Health and the School of Medicine. Polk held a faculty appointment in the Department of Epidemiology within the School of Hygiene and Public Health and a joint faculty appointment in the School of Medicine, in the Department of Gynecology and Obstetrics and in the Department of Medicine. These documents also include a small set of records pertaining to Polk's work at the Johns Hopkins Hospital.

The first set of records pertain to Polk's activities within the School of Hygiene and Public Health as a whole; it includes Advisory Council minutes and correspondence from the Institute for International Programs (IIP), an interdepartmental program for addressing health problems in developing countries. Polk was an IIP Advisory Council member. Polk also participated in several school-wide committees and this set of records contains memorandum and meeting minutes. The second set of materials comprise Polk's Department of Epidemiology records including committee files, correspondence, course work, faculty files, meeting materials, and student advising files. Correspondence pertaining to engagements and talks by Polk at many organizations and within the Johns Hopkins University are located in the section labeled administrative files. The School of Medicine and Hospital records contain Polk's Committee work for both and files pertaining to the AIDS treatment facilities at the Hospital.

The First AIDS Service was the clinical care component of the Johns Hopkins Hospital for AIDS patients, including inpatient and outpatient services. It was organized in 1985 to provide quality and compassionate care utilizing a multidisciplinary staff from the Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions and with assistance from the community. Services included medical and nursing care, social services, and emotional support for patients and their families. It also included a research setting to develop and evaluate treatments as well as a staff skilled in treating the disease. Staff were chosen on the basis of their interest in AIDS care and research.

The Joseph Earle Moore Clinic, known as the Moore Clinic, was an outpatient unit of the Johns Hopkins Hospital that was the center of AIDS research and patient treatment at Hopkins. It was the largest AIDS care program in the state of Maryland. The Clinic's Directors have included Joseph Earle Moore, Victor McKusick, William D. Hillis, John Bartlett, William Ruby, Richard Chaisson, and Joel Gallant.

The clinic opened in 1915 as the Venereal Disease Clinic for the purposes of studying and treating syphilis. At the time, the clinic was also called "Department L," referring to an old name for the disease, lues venerea. During World War II, with the introduction of penicillin in the United States, syphilis was brought under control. In 1953, Joseph Earle Moore transformed the clinic into a center for treating chronic diseases, called the "Medicine I Clinic." The clinic was renamed the Joseph Earle Moore Clinic in 1958 in honor of its longtime director and pioneer in the field of venereal diseases who had died in December 1957. Under the subsequent director, Dr. Victor McKusick, the focus of the clinic changed to genetic conditions. The Moore Clinic was designated a Clinical Research Center (CRC) in 1973 and researchers were invited to submit study protocols to conduct outpatient clinical research trials on a small scale. John Bartlett, Chief of the Infectious Diseases Division, and Epidemiologist, Frank Polk, changed the clinic's focus once more to HIV/AIDS in 1984 and the Moore Clinic became the first AIDS clinic in Maryland. Bartlett and Polk each set aside a half day a week to care for a small group of gay men with AIDS. Polk designed a research project that was the first epidemiological study of the disease, which subsequently became the design for the Multicenter AIDS Cohort Study (MACS), a longitudinal study with research sites in Los Angeles, Philadelphia, Baltimore, and Chicago, and which is still ongoing. Polk and Bartlett treated and studied the first MACS patients through the Baltimore arm of the study, SHARE (Study to Help the AIDS Research Effort). The staff of the Moore Clinic was multidisciplinary and services included physical examination, lab tests, and counselling. From 1984 until 1987, there was no charge to AIDS patients for care and as of 1987 only those who could afford to pay were charged for services. With its approval and funding as an AIDS Treatment and Evaluation Unit (ATEU) in 1986, patients gained access to new treatments including experimental AIDS drugs. After Polk's untimely death in 1988 of a brain tumor, Polk's leadership during these years persisted and the clinic with its focus on HIV care continued to grow. Bartlett oversaw the international research effort that resulted in 1997 in the development of the antiretroviral drug therapy for treating HIV infection.

Residing until 2017 in the Carnegie Building of the Johns Hopkins Hospital, the outpatient unit was known as the Moore Clinic for HIV Care. Supervised by the Hopkins AIDS Service, it offered services specialized for patients with HIV infection. The Moore Clinic ceased operation when the Johns Hopkins Hospital opened John G. Bartlett Specialty Practice for Patients with Infectious Diseases on May 8, 2017 in the Edwards Park Building. The new Bartlett Specialty Practice co-locates much needed services for patients with a range of infectious diseases, including HIV.

The subject files include documents pertaining to transmission, research, and treatment of gynecological and AIDS-related medical disorders. Materials include correspondence, photocopied journal articles, hand written notes, research studies, human subjects forms, research questionnaires, conference programs, lecture materials, papers reviewed by Polk, abstracts, progress reports, grant applications and research proposals for studies by Polk. Interspersed among the subject files are files about faculty and administrators at Johns Hopkins and elsewhere. This series also contains files pertaining to the Joint

Committee on Clinical Investigation (JCCI), which was in charge of human subjects review at Johns Hopkins University. JCCI files include procedures updates, research project notification and consent forms for studies for which Polk was the investigator, as well as one annual renewal request for a study for which Polk was a reviewer. GRID, Gay Related Immune Deficiency was an early name for AIDS.

Sub-series 4.2: AIDS Files - 1983-1988

Creator:

AIDS Clinical Trials Group (ACTG)

The AIDS Clinical Trials Group (ACTG) was established in 1987 and funded by the Department of Health and Human Services. The objective was to broaden the scope of the AIDS research of the NIAID. It established the largest network of clinical investigators and clinical trials units in the world. The mission was to investigate the viral and immune pathogenesis of HIV infections and its complications; to evaluate approaches and strategies for treatment; and promote the publication and dissemination of study findings.

AIDS Treatment and Evaluation Unit (ATEU)

In 1986 the first AIDS Treatment and Evaluation Units (ATEU) were established by the National Institutes of Health to examine treatment options for HIV infection. Johns Hopkins was one of 19 centers approved by the NIH as a federally funded ATEU. The research was focused on new treatments that prevented HIV from replicating. The unit was set up to test experimental drugs on AIDS patients. The Principal Investigator of the Johns Hopkins ATEU was John Bartlett, Chief of the Division of Infectious Diseases. Data from ATEU studies was gathered and analyzed by the AIDS Clinical Trials Coordinating Center to facilitate collaborative studies and speed up the evaluation of drugs.

In 1983, Frank Polk, Epidemiologist, designed a study to follow the natural history of AIDS among gay and bisexual men. The National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID) within the National Institutes of Health funded Polk's project as part of a collaborative study known as the

Multicenter AIDS Cohort Study (MACS). Polk was the principle

investigator and an advisory board member of SHARE, the Study to Help the AIDS Research Effort, the name of the Baltimore center of MACS. Starting in 1983, collaboration began among the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine, the Johns Hopkins University School of Hygiene and Public Health, the City of Baltimore, the State of Maryland, local gay organizations, and the University of Maryland. Study participants were seen at the Johns Hopkins Hospital Moore Clinic on four evenings a week and on one weekend day. They were given medical evaluations at three to six month intervals.

Polk recruited a lawyer who was a lobbyist and gay rights activist to lead the SHARE Advisory Board and to select Board members, which helped to reach men in the gay community, learn about their concerns and political issues, and obtain their confidence. It was important to ascertain that the investigators were not evaluating homosexuality per se. Another concern was that the researchers would guarantee confidentiality to volunteers who

feared being stigmatized. In 1987, the Johns Hopkins University
Department of Epidemiology, within the School of Hygiene and Public
Health, was awarded a contract to be the Center for the Analysis and
Management of the MACS study data (CAMACS). MACS is a longitudinal
study and is still ongoing. The three other centers are located in Los

Angeles, Philadelphia, and Chicago.

Natural History of Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) in Homosexual Men," September 29, 1987 (See Reports); and the October 1983 SHARE Advisory Board minutes that contain notes on the rationale for the study, the advantage of having a cohort study, interest in addressing psychological stress and depression, concerns over possible weaknesses in the study, how to address Gay issues that researchers were unfamiliar with, facilitating discussion about gay social and political issues, issues pertaining to methodology, the study's relationship with the press, and Johns Hopkins personnel policies concerning gay employees. MACS-related studies include: Diarrhea Study; Evaluation of Delayed Hypersensitivity to Skin Testing Among Gay Men; Evaluation of a new Antibody Assay for HTLV-III; and Neuropsychological Studies (Neurologic and Psychiatric Manifestation of the HTLV-III Infection or Neoropsych Study).
