Collection Overview

Creator: Church Home and Hospital Nurses' Alumnae Association

Administrative/Biographical History:

The Alumnae Association of the Church Home and Hospital School of Nursing was founded in 1904, as stated in its charter, for graduates' "mutual association and improvement, the promotion of fellowship among its members, the advancement of the best interest of trained nurses, and the maintenance and elevation of the standards of professional nursing." In 1914, with Jane Nash's assistance, the association created a nurses' registry to aid in placing graduate nurses in positions. It selected an emblem for its nursing pin, a black Greek cross with the gold embossed monogram of Church Home and Hospital. They chose a motto in German, "Ich dien," or "I serve." In 1920, this motto was changed to its Latin equivalent, "Ego servo." During the years of World War II, the annual dances were cancelled, and members serving in the war were relieved of paying their dues.

One of the association's primary legacies is of financing continuing education and studies of its members. The scholarship fund began in 1930, and continues today. Funds were also devoted to current CHHSON students, who then had to sign a two-year contract to work at CHH, and to alumae to continue their studies elsewhere. In 1984, it inaugurated a scholarship given to a graduate of the Johns Hopkins University School of Nursing. The association also acted philanthropically in many other ways; in 1941, they presented the Hospital with a portrait of the Drs. Davis, Hunner, and Cullen.

The alumnae association also has a history of publishing. The first alumnae newsletter was published in 1916. A brief history and yearbook was published in 1929 to celebrate the twenty-fifth anniversary of the association. In 1954 it commissioned Judith Robinson to author a history of the School and Hospital for its fiftieth anniversary. The resulting book, Ensign on a Hill, is an excellent anecdotal source on the history of these institutions.

The association has an active social calendar, and has a membership-wide meeting, now held in conjunction with the Homecoming celebrations of fellow Consortium for Nursing Education members, Johns Hopkins Nurses' Alumni Association, with whom they formally merged in 2004.

Scope and Content:

The records of the Church Home and Hospital Nurses' Alumnae Association consist of documents outlining its governance, correspondence and several publications. Particularly well-documented are some of the Association's committee activities, especially the Scholarship Committee. Financial records from the period of 1953 to 1973 are also strong. Incomplete but broad series of the Association's newsletter may be found from 1936 to 2003. Copies of the alumnae newsletter provide a record of the association's activities, and note important updates in the lives of its members.

Scope and Content:

The correspondence series of the Alumnae Association contains general correspondence between alumnae and the board, and between the board and other institutions or organizations. The correspondence with the board spans the 1940s to 2001, and reflects the changing leadership of the association. The association also interacted a great deal with the Johns Hopkins University School of Nursing, and records from 1987 to 1994 include various event invitations and discussions about nursing education. Sub-record group/Sous-fonds: Governance and Administration

Scope and Content:

The Governance and Administration record group consists of Alumnae Association constitution and bylaws, board of directors records, committee records, and financial records. The series of constitution and bylaws runs from 1925 to 1995, with a new copy for each revision. The records of the scholarship committee are particularly detailed, and provide a history of alumnae philanthropy and education. The financial records also detail the association's focus on fundraising. Cash receipt and disbursement books from 1954 to 1973 offer a detailed account of the association's business transactions. Records of the board of directors are minimal, as tasks were generally dispersed among committees. See also the correspondence records of the board.

Scope and Content:

The records of the alumnae association board of directors include address lists, meeting agendas, and job descriptions for committee chair positions. The records are strong for some periods, largely depending upon the president at the time. Nancye Ross-Bogardy's tenure from 1987 to 1992 has many records and correspondence. Many of the activities of the alumnae association were handled by committees, and more records can be found in committee records and correspondence files.

Scope and Content: The publications of the Alumnae Association consist of newsletters, recruitment

brochures and histories. The Bulletin ran from 1936 to 1960 with a break from 1941-1945. The Alumnae News was published from 1960 to 1990, succeeded by The Ensign which ran until 2003. This full series of alumnae newsletters offers an excellent history of the association, its members, and its activities. The association also published recruitment materials for Church Home and Hospital nursing service and later for Johns Hopkins University School of Nursing. Always interested in preserving its history, the association also participated in the publication of a 25th Anniversary History in 1929 and a book in

honor of its 50th Anniversary, Judith Robinson's Ensign on a Hill.
