Vivien T. Thomas was born in Lake Providence, Louisiana on August 29, 1910. His family later moved to Nashville, Tennessee, where he was educated in the public schools. In 1929, after working as an orderly in a private infirmary to raise money for college, he enrolled as a premedical student at Tennessee Agricultural and Industrial College. The bank crash that year wiped out his life's savings, forcing him to drop out of school. In 1930, he took a position at Vanderbilt University as a laboratory assistant with Alfred Blalock. Thomas' abilities as a surgical assistant and research associate were of the highest quality, and when Blalock moved to Johns Hopkins in 1941 he asked Thomas to accompany him. Thomas joined Blalock's surgical team and helped to develop the procedure used in the "blue baby" operation. He helped train many of the surgeons at Johns Hopkins in the delicate techniques necessary for heart and lung operations. Thomas was a member of the medical school faculty from 1976 until 1985 and was presented with the degree of Honorary Doctor of Laws by the Johns Hopkins University in 1976.

Scope and Content:

The Vivien T. Thomas Collection spans his entire career at Vanderbilt and Johns Hopkins . Constituting the bulk of the collection is the manuscript and its various drafts for the memoir which was eventually published by The University of Pennsylvania Press, titled Pioneering Research in Surgical Shock and Cardiovascular Surgery: Vivien

Thomas and His Work with Alfred Blalock (1985), later republished as Partners of the Heart: Vivien Thomas and his work with Alfred Blalock (1998). Also included is a large volume of correspondence between Thomas and numerous Hopkins medical staff, predominantly on professional topics. The most prolific correspondent is Mark Ravitch, a doctor who became Thomas' mentor and editor during his writing of the memoir. Additionally, the collection includes material related to the experimental animal surgery of Vanderbilt and Johns Hopkins, reprints of seminal medical articles, biographical material and ephemera Thomas collected over his lifetime related to the hospital and cardiac surgery.

Series 1: Correspondence

Scope and Content: Vivien Thomas' correspondence is an important and fascinating historical record of letters exchanged between Thomas and a number of Hopkins medical staff from 1953 up to his death in 1985. Though often warm in tone, most of these letters are professional in nature, limiting their concerns to that of the hospital and the occupational lives of colleagues. In some cases there is a development of intimacy as the correspondence proceeds. We can see an example of this in the stark difference between Ravitch's first letter to Thomas in 1953 and to his last letters to Thomas in 1985, as professional practicalities give way to genuine personal attachment. Because of his sustained mentorship over Thomas' autobiography, Mark Ravitch is the most prolific correspondent in the collection. In the period 1979 – 1985, drafts of the autobiography are passed between Thomas and Ravitch, with Ravitch providing commentary by letter and encouraging Thomas towards completion.

It is in the correspondence that we learn of the editorial process of the manuscript.

Ravitch is not an overbearing editor, and beyond grammatical issues, he suggests minimal changes to the manuscript. However, Ravitch does intervene in encouraging Thomas to expound in greater detail some of the surgical procedures he was involved in, which results in long passages of very technical vocabulary sometimes more suited to a textbook than a memoir. For a while this actually hinders the publication of the book, as it is feared by publishers to be overly obscure to a non-medical audience.

An important omission from the manuscript is something Thomas was personally very interested in, which we can tell from his significant collections of articles and clippings on this topic (see 5 series Subject Files). Alcoholism in the medical profession quite seriously impacted the lives of a number of doctors at Hopkins, particularly Blalock and Thomas, yet makes only a fleeting appearance at the beginning of the memoir. It is in the correspondence between Thomas and Ravitch that we find a striking account of Blalock's alcohol dependency, particularly as it worsens late in his life.

The collection also features correspondence exchanged after Thomas' death, principally between Clara Thomas and various medical staff at Hopkins. An item of note is Helen Taussig's card to Clara Thomas upon her husband's death in which she expresses her high regard and deep fondness for him. There is also further correspondence between Ravitch and University of Pennsylvania Press, mostly on administrative topics.

Archival Arrangement: Each correspondence sub-series is arranged alphabetically by correspondent. Within alphabetized correspondents, the material is organized chronologically. The letters between Vivien Thomas and Mark Ravitch are about half of the correspondence and are arranged chronologically in a separate sub-series. The second subseries is Thomas correspondence with other people excluding Ravitch. Since she communicated so extensively with a broad range of people after Thomas' death, Clara Thomas' correspondence has its own subseries; the same goes for Mark Ravitch's letters to people other than Vivien Thomas.

Series 2: Vivien Thomas Autobiography

Scope and Content: Late in his career, Vivien Thomas began writing a memoir of his time as a surgical technician at The Johns Hopkins Hospital. With the generosity and encouragement of Mark Ravitch, Thomas prepared a document from a perspective of exceptional insight. Thomas was the first black surgical technician at Johns Hopkins at a time of racial segregation and social inequality, and his memoir represents a fascinating account of being both at the forefront of surgical innovation and excluded from certain types of recognition. Some fifteen years elapsed between the first recorded instance of Thomas's idea to write a memoir and its eventual publication just before his death in 1986. The series consists of a large volume of drafts, both handwritten and typed, which eventually comprised the manuscript as published by UPenn Press (1st edition 1985, 2nd edition 1998). Between editions, a change of title occurred from "Pioneering Research in Surgical Shock and Cardiovascular Surgery: Vivien Thomas and His Work with Alfred Blalock" to "Partners of the heart: Vivien Thomas and his work with Alfred Blalock." These manuscripts regularly passed between Thomas and Ravitch, with Ravitch frequently providing handwritten edits on each draft at Thomas' request.

Archival Arrangement: These manuscripts have been ordered into eras of productivity rather than strict drafts. It appears that 1980-1983 was the period of highest productivity, with correspondence between Ravitch and Thomas also increasing during this period as the reality of publication approaches. The typed items were often photocopied numerous times and edited by hand. The most reproduced draft is dated November 1982, noted as 11/1982, which forms the foundation of the final manuscript and after this point undergoes only very cosmetic alterations. Because of the proliferation of photocopied drafts, it is important to remember that drafts labeled 11/1982 might actually reflect the editing processes of a later date. Where possible, this has been indicated by the placement of the manuscripts in different boxes. Because Thomas did not date much of his work, some materials have had to be placed in 'undated' and 'undated handwritten', but they are largely arranged in chapters. Both published editions of the book share the same chapter order and numbering, but the prologue of the 1985 edition is cut in the 1998 edition. Apart from the title and cover, presence of the prologue is the only difference between the two editions. During his writing process, Thomas includes the prologue as 'chapter one', which pushes all the other chapters forward one place. The collection arrangement, however, matches the chapter order to that of the published books. For example, a draft might be labeled by Thomas as 'chapter ten', but be titled in the arrangement as 'chapter nine'.

Thomas was not necessarily the most systematic writer, and alternatives of the same drafts are not necessarily successive nor do they always incorporate recent edits. These alternatives are indicated with 'a' and 'b', or '1' and '2'. Vignettes which did not make it into the manuscript have been indicated, with the most significant omissions being private commentary on Thomas's lack of invitation to Dr. Alfred Blalock's retirement party, race relations at Johns Hopkins, and reflections on the meaning of the honorary degree and portrait that are much more complicated than what appears in the published work.

Series 4: Writings and Speeches

Scope and Content: This series predominantly features reprints of articles by Hopkins medical staff collected by Thomas over the course of his life. It is very likely that they were a useful resource while working in surgery and while writing the autobiography. But Thomas' collection of reprints also served another function. Throughout his career, the racial politics of the time meant that his contribution to surgical practice was frequently overlooked. One way this manifested was in the repeated failure of medical staff to cite Thomas as a co-author of articles he had contributed to, as is repeatedly referred to in the autobiography. Collecting these reprints enabled Thomas to monitor his own professional recognition in the articles Hopkins staff produced. This series also features bibliographies of important doctors working closely with Thomas such as Alfred Blalock. Again, it is likely that Thomas' assimilation of these documents was for more than simply reference purposes.

The series also contains a large box of books that had belonged to Thomas, almost all of which are directly related to his work in dog surgery and the heart. Books of note include Longmire's reflections on Alfred Blalock after his death, and Helen Taussig's Congenital Malformations of the Heart.

There are also a small number of speeches, primarily by Thomas related to his work.

Archival Arrangement: The arrangement for this series is mainly dictated by format. Reprints featuring Thomas as a co-author are placed in a separate subseries, and organized chronologically. Reprints in which Thomas is not listed as an author are in a series organized alphabetically by the first author listed. Books are also kept in their own box.

Series 5: Subject Files

Scope and Content: This series features articles, clippings and ephemera collected by Vivien Thomas and organized into three distinct areas of interest. The first, and possibly most intriguing, is that of 'Alcoholism in the medical community,' a file which includes resources on the definition of alcohol dependence and guidance for receiving help. From the correspondence between Ravitch and Thomas, it is apparent that Thomas struggled personally with alcohol but was able to eventually overcome his issues, though this is never elaborated extensively in the collection. An item of note is the article by Ransom R. Buchholz which reveals his own drinking problem and describes the culture of alcoholism amongst doctors and surgeons that allows addiction to flourish. Interestingly, alcoholism is rarely mentioned in the autobiography. For Thomas' account of Blalock's late alcoholism and attempts at recovery, see the March 8, 1981 handwritten letter from Thomas to Ravitch.

Next is Johns Hopkins related magazines, articles and clippings, a collection which features a broad range of Hopkins related ephemera.

Finally there are 'Invitations and Event Programs at Johns Hopkins' which features items such as invitations for special events, menus and programs. An item of note is the invitation for Helen Taussig's 82nd surprise birthday party which was to be held in the hospital lobby. Material related to hospital events, including speeches (such as that given by Alfred Blalock on his retirement), give an interesting insight into the surgeon community and raise important questions about the roles of prestige, reputation and public self-image. Contrasting these speeches with details given in Thomas' private correspondence makes for a complex portrait of hospital life.

Series 6: Research and Laboratory Materials
